Attention FHIAP member:

Your FHIAP subsidy ends May 31, 2008

It is with great sadness that we announce that a recent federal ruling forces us to end the FHIAP subsidy for members of your family age 19 and older on May 31, 2008. However, you still have some ways to keep health insurance. Please read the *FHIAP Transition Guide* for information to help you make a decision on your health insurance. To make this work smoothly, we need the green *Family Selections* form returned to us **by April 18**. You may:

1. Ask FHIAP to move adults in your family to the Oregon Health Plan (OHP) Standard benefit package. **By choosing to enroll in OHP Standard on the green form and returning it, you will not need to fill out an OHP application.** You will be in OHP Standard for six months, starting June 1. Shortly before the end of your six months in OHP, you must apply to see if you are eligible to keep your OHP Standard coverage. Most clients are required to enroll in a managed care plan (see the question "Can I keep my doctor" in the *FHIAP Transition Guide* for more information). If you chose to move to OHP, they will send you more information about OHP coverage and an information form to complete and return.

OR

2. Notify your insurance company that, starting June 1, you will pay the entire premium to continue your health plan for adults in your family. The insurance company will begin to bill you directly. (FHIAP will still help pay for children.) **Please return the green form to FHIAP.**

If you have children:

Children are not affected by this federal ruling. That means you can keep your children with FHIAP. However, if you want the whole family in OHP, you must apply for the children. They can't be automatically enrolled like the adults. **Please tell us on the green form what you want to do.**

Your last FHIAP bill:

In just a few days, you will receive your final FHIAP bill that includes adult coverage. It will have a due date of April 21. Pay this FHIAP bill to make sure you're covered for May.
