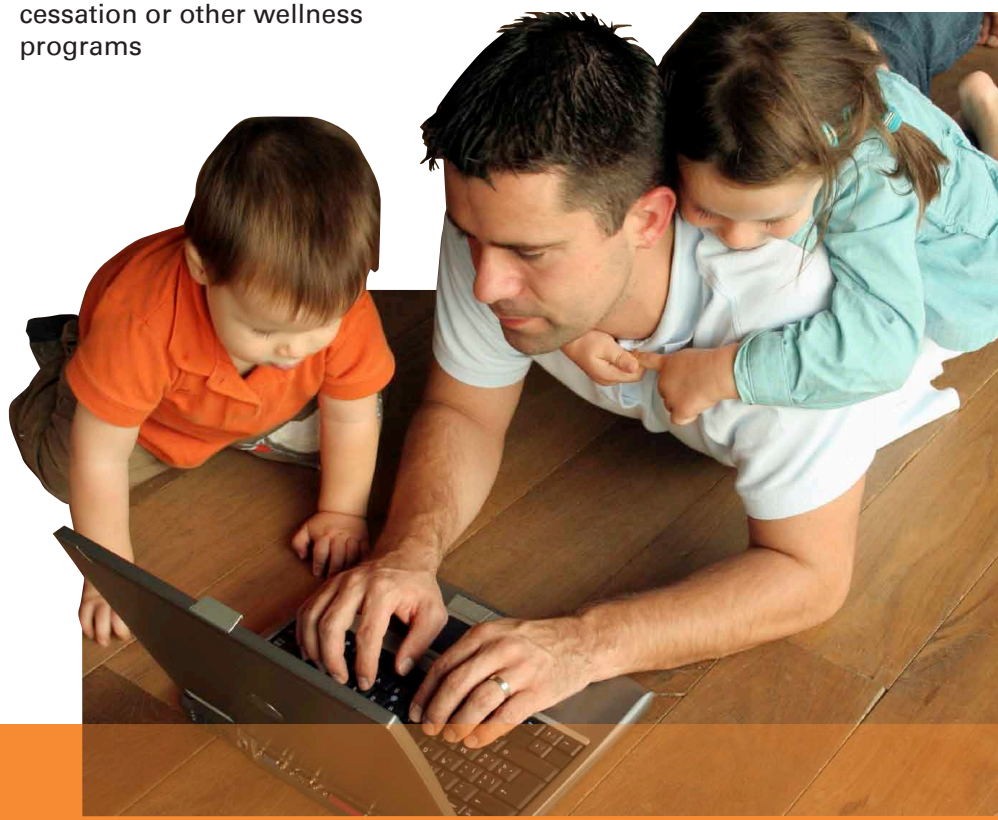
Once you've registered, you can review claim and coverage information, check your family enrollment history, find resources to help you manage your health, and more—at your convenience from any computer with Internet access.

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Online Access to Your Coverage Information

InTouch makes it easy for you to manage your coverage and information.

1. Health Plan Snapshot

- Click on your name to view your profile.
- Click on your plan name to see how much expense has accumulated toward your plan's deductible, stop-loss, or out-of-pocket maximum. You can track your share of healthcare expenses (such as deductibles and copayments) by family member and year.

2. Your Profile

- Track your family's enrollment history and check the coordination of benefits information we have on file.
- Check the status of preauthorizations or referrals.

- Notify us when your name or address changes.
- Select a new primary care physician.

3. Your Health Plan

- Click on Your Health Plan on the left side of the home page to look up your medical claims information for the past two years.

4. Health Manager

- Access health and wellness resources relevant to you and your dependents (for details, see the Health Manager section).

5. Health Risk Assessment

- Uncover potential health risks and take positive steps to control them.

6. Provider Directory

- Locate a doctor, specialist, or facility that meets your healthcare needs.

7. Track Requests

- Review any InTouch requests you've made, such as an address change.

Health Manager is on call 24/7.

- Symptom Checker helps you determine if and when you should seek medical treatment.
- Disease and Condition Centers give you current, reliable information about specific healthcare issues.

Improve Your health

- Try out Lifestyle Improvement Programs (LIPs), which cover topics of *Exercise*, *Weight Management*, *Stress Management*, *Nutrition*, and *Smoking Cessation*. These programs include planners and information to engage you in your health.
- Set up a customized meal planner and print a grocery list in the *Nutrition* program.
- Create an exercise plan that fits your needs and watch demos on various exercises when you use the *Exercise* program.

To start using PacificSource InTouch, simply visit our Web site and register:


1. Browse to PacificSource.com.
2. Click on the Register Now link in the upper right corner of your screen.
3. Follow the instructions.

Once you accept the registration agreement, you will be asked to enter your Member ID number and Group ID number, which can be found on your PacificSource ID card (see example), as well as your birth date and e-mail address. Your Member ID number is the Member ID number shown on the card, plus the two-digit ID number next to your name.

After entering all required information, click Submit. In a few seconds, you'll automatically be logged into your account.

For security reasons, no confirmation e-mail will be sent. Be sure to keep your user ID and password in a secure place. Should you forget your password, simply select the Forgot My Password link on the login page.
